

**Town of Alna**  
**Warrant for Special Town Meeting**  
**November 1, 2024, 6PM**

**To:** Honor Sage, Civil Constable of the Town of Alna, County of Lincoln, and State of Maine.

**GREETINGS:** In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Alna, in said County, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at the Alna Firehouse on Friday, the first of November 2024 at 6:00pm to act on articles one through five, said articles being set out below to wit:

**Article 1:** To elect a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

*The Clerk called for nominations. Carl Pease and Chris Cooper were both nominated. Carl Pease was elected as Moderator by written ballot.*

**Article 2:** To see if the town will (1) authorize the Select board to take any and all actions necessary for the receipt and use of grant funds from the Maine Connectivity Authority related to a collaborative project with Consolidated Communications for the construction of a broadband fiber network to serve the Town's residents; (2) authorize the Select board to enter any agreements necessary and appropriate between the Town, Maine Connectivity Authority and Consolidated Communications related to said grant and the construction of the fiber network; and (3) appropriate \$10,500 from State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (also known as American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA funds) received by the Town from the federal government for the following project: Broadband service/infrastructure and connectivity.

**Article 3:** To see if the Town will vote to appropriate up to \$7,500. from State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (also known as American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA funds) received by the Town from the federal government for town office and town computer upgrades, including adding a second workstation at the front counter, replacing an existing computer at the town office, purchasing a credit/debit card module from TRIO, and/or lighting for the town flagpole.

**Article 4:** To see if the Town will vote to appropriate up to \$40,000. from State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (also known as American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA funds) received by the Town from the federal government to make necessary improvements to the Bailey Road.


**Article 5:** To see if the Town will vote to appropriate up to \$20,000. From State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (also known as American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA funds) received by the Town from the federal government to purchase surface gravel for town roads.

**Article 6:** To see if the Town will vote to release from undesignated funds up to \$167,000 to expend for the non-federal match requirement by the National Culvert Removal, Replacement and Restoration Grant awarded to MaineDOT for the replacement of the Egypt Road bridge project.
