

BECOME A LOCAL CLIMATE LEADER!

The Town of Alna is seeking community members to form a **Municipal Climate Action Committee**.

This small group of individuals will coordinate activities aiming to reduce energy use and costs, invest in renewable energy, and make the town more resilient to climate change.

Forming a committee is one key step in the process to enroll Alna in the Community Resilience Partnership (CRP), a state program created by the Governor's Office of Policy Innovation and the Future aimed at helping Maine communities become more resilient to the local impacts of climate change. Through enrolling in the CRP, Alna will become eligible for grants and direct support to carry out local climate resilience projects.

Key responsibilities of the committee will include:

- Completing a **Community Resilience Self Assessment** and reviewing a **List of Community Actions** for the town
- Assisting with hosting a **Public Workshop**
- Developing a **Municipal Resolution** to be passed by the Town that identifies priority climate action areas
- Deciding on the top climate priority project to apply for a **Community Action Grant**.
