Hi Honor,

I am pleased to let you know that the Alna Planning Board at our April 5<sup>th</sup> meeting approved your application for the removal of Japanese knotweed an invasive species from areas on your property (Map R7 Lot 36) that are within the shoreland zone.

The permit application is good for a two year period and expires on April 4, 2025. If the knotweed removal activities need to extend beyond the expiration date of the approval you will need to apply for an extension. As noted in the meeting a separate application for a revegetation plan will need to be filed and approved prior to beginning revegetation activities.

I would also note that one condition was placed on the approved application. That condition states that you will follow IF&W guidelines for any managed burns that take place to remove dead material in the stands of Japanese knotweed.
